Maintenance

1. Clean your bamboo floor with a soft dry or damp cloth.
2. Do not leave any liquids standing on the floor for extended periods of time.
3. Be sure that feet and shoes are free of any abrasive dust, dirt or grit that might scratch the surface of your bamboo flooring.
4. Avoid walking on your bamboo floor with metal shoe taps and sharp high heels.
5. Apply wax and or protective coatings as needed depending on the location and the amount of foot traffic on the newly floored area to maintain the appearance of your bamboo floor.
6. Open outside windows and or doors when convenient to allow for the ongoing acclimatization of your bamboo floor.

About Bamboo

While bamboo shares many qualities with timber it is not a hardwood. Bamboo is technically a variety of grass, which when mature can be processed into a product that is much denser and stronger than a hardwood. Bamboo is a 100% renewable resource and grows much faster than hardwoods.

There are more than 1000 existing varieties of bamboo but we use only the Mao Bamboo. Mao Bamboo is superior for flooring and paneling due to its large diameter, colour, structure, density and superior strength.

Mao Bamboo can grow at a rate of approximately two to three feet per day in the first 24 months after sprouting in spring. After six months the bamboo stalk is considered to be mature. After five to six years the bamboo takes on properties far greater than hardwoods and is ready for harvest and processing into flooring.

Bamboo is a naturally beautiful and durable renewable alternative to our limited global supply of slow growth hardwoods.

Environmentally Friendly

Hardwoods have historically been the principle building material for both the developed and developing economies and societies on our planet. As a result forest resources and animal habitations have seriously been depleted.

In such a case bamboo becomes a perfect alternative construction material that can lessen our dependence on hardwoods and allow global forests to regenerate in a natural manner.

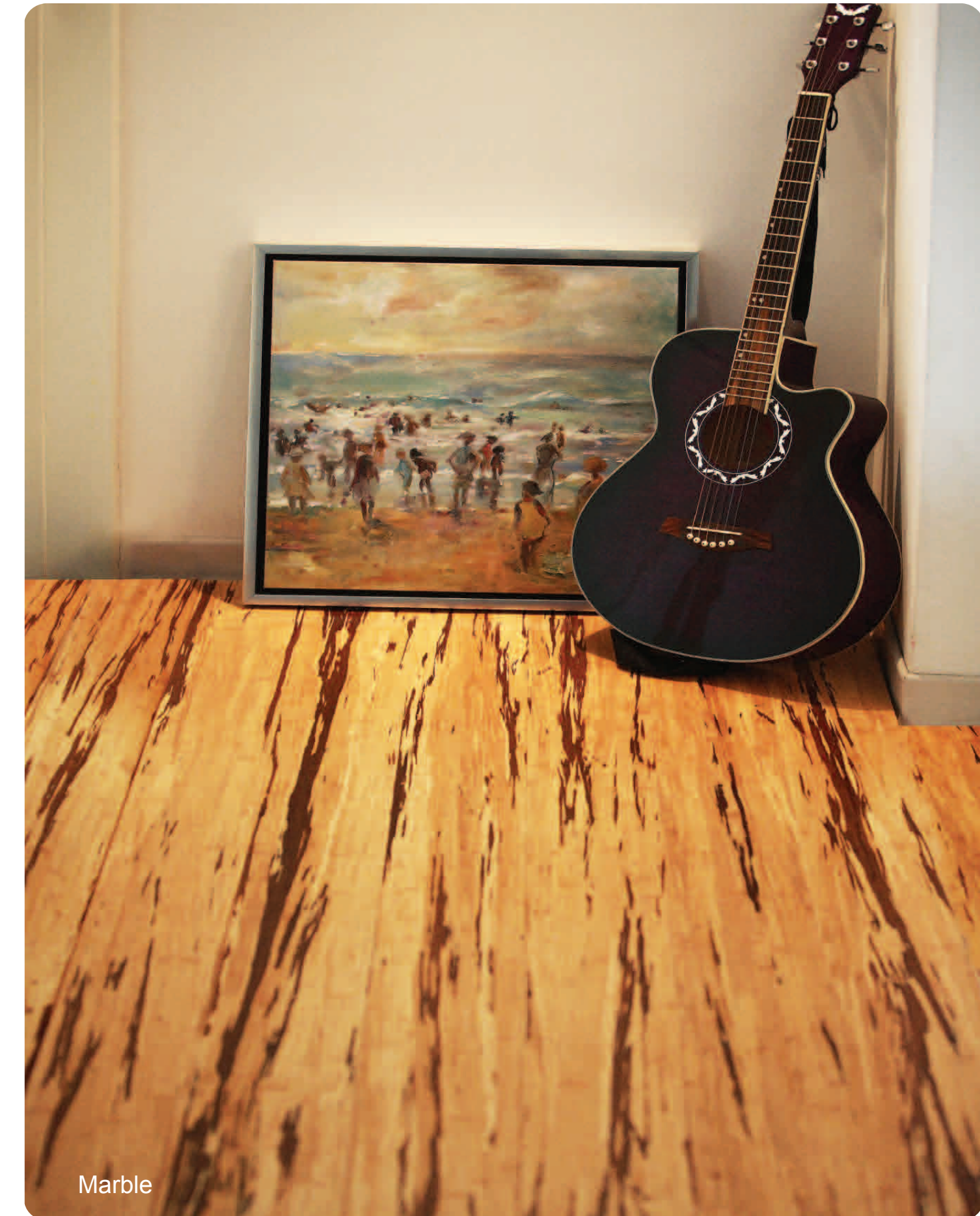
